ACRF has offices in Anchorage, Fairbanks, and Wasilla and is a program of Northwest Resource Associates.

Hours and location

This full-time (40 hours per week) position will be working with families served by the Fairbanks ACRF office including communities in the Northern OCS Region. It includes helping with coverage in the office, so priority consideration will be given to residents in the Fairbanks North Star Borough.

Salary and benefits

We offer 3.5 to 6 weeks of paid vacation per year, 15 to 16 paid holidays per year, paid sick leave, a generous family leave policy, a retirement plan, optional 403b plan, medical and dental insurance, life insurance, disability insurance, long-term care insurance, and commuter benefits. The annual salary for this full-time position is \$53,000.
